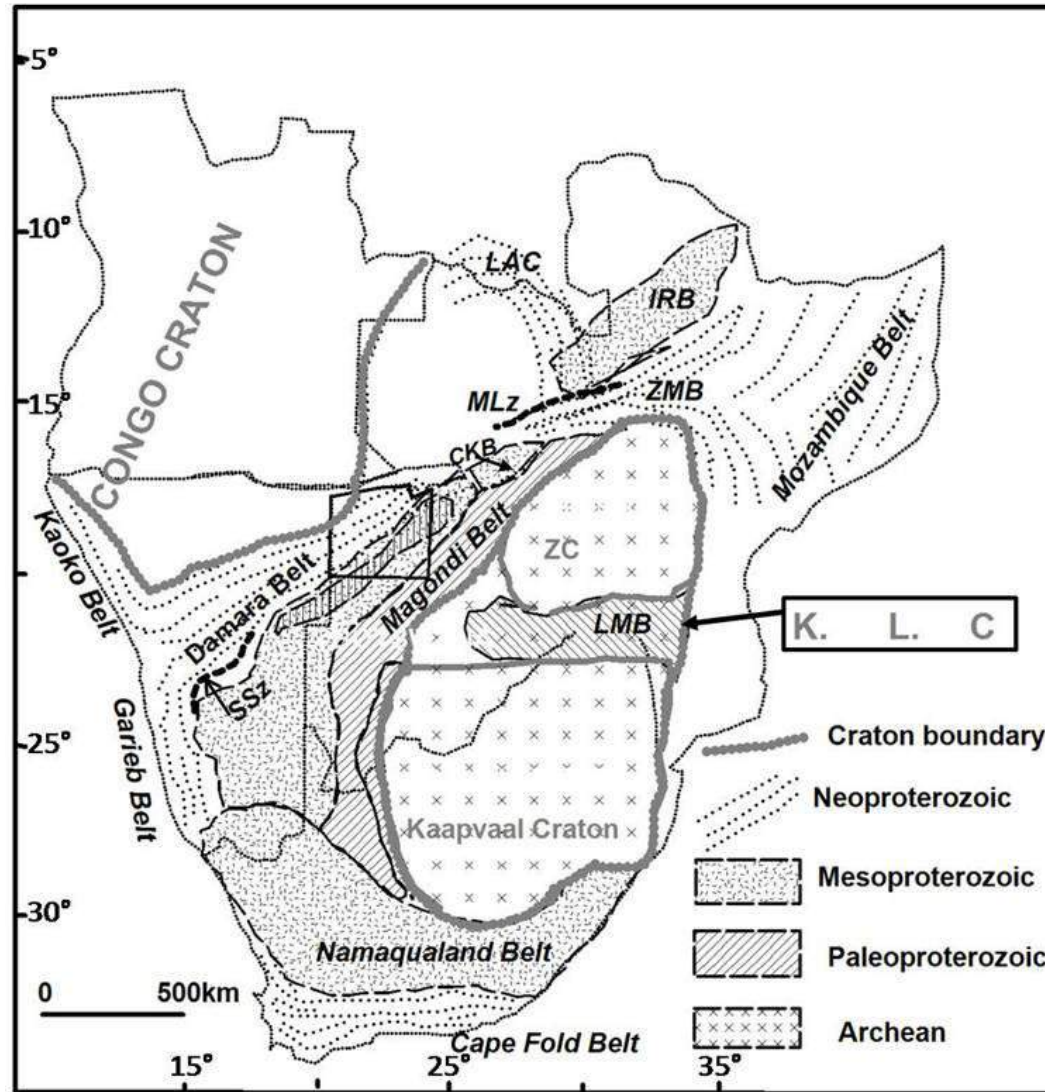

Tectonic setting of the study area (black box) within the larger tectonic framework of Southern Africa. Abbreviated belts are: CKB-Choma Kalomo Block, IRB-Irumide Belt, LAC-Lulian Arc, LMB-Limpopo Mobile Belt, ZMB-Zambezi Belt. Cratons are: K.L.C-Kalahari Craton, ZC-Zimbabwe Craton. K.L.C. comprises of the Kaapvaal and Zimbabwe cratons. Shear zones: MSz-Mwembeshi, SSz-Schliesen.
